Jay Allen Award for Distinguished Editorial Service to SSHSA publications. Jay Allen, one of SSHSA's seven founders, published the first *Steamboat Bill of Facts* in April 1940, assisted by C. Bradford Mitchell. *Steamboat Bill of Facts*, subsequently renamed *Steamboat Bill*, and now *PowerShips*, has been published continuously without fail, and today is recognized as the most comprehensive and best publication of its kind.
